



Title: California Senate Bill 1443

Subject: Sunset Extension

Summary:

California Senate Bill 1443 extends the statutory sunset of the consumer goods service contract law in Section 9855.9 from January 1, 2023, to January 1, 2024. The bill also extends the sunset provisions of various sections relating to the authorized responsibilities of the Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs over service contractors from January 1, 2023, to January 1, 2024.

The bill makes similar changes to other sunset provisions.
