



Title: New Jersey Assembly Bill 3892

Subject: Auto Renew

Summary:

New Jersey Assembly Bill 3892 requires “[a] subscription service provider selling subscription services online shall provide a consumer with an online option to cancel the subscription.” Additionally, the bill requires the subscription service provider to provide to any eligible consumer, “in a conspicuous and visible manner and in a prominent location, a direct link or button by which a consumer can cancel a subscription to the service The link or button shall make it clear that its purpose is to cancel the subscription.”

The bill defines “subscription service provider” as “a person who sells a subscription service to a consumer online.”

“Subscription service” means “a service provided on a subscription basis in exchange for a reoccurring payment, including, but not limited to, a weekly, monthly, or annual payment charged to and made by a consumer.”

The bill makes violations an unlawful practice and violation of the consumer fraud act.

If passed, this bill shall take effect immediately.
