



**Title:** South Dakota Senate Bill 160

**Subject:** Service Contracts

**Summary:**

**This bill has been signed by the Governor and will be effective July 1, 2022.**

South Dakota Senate Bill 160 is legislation pursued by MVPPA which amends the existing motor vehicle service contract description to expressly authorize the following coverages:

- Tire and wheel;
- Windshield repair or replacement;
- Paintless dent repair;
- Key or Key-Fob; and
- Excess wear and use.

The bill also amends the description of service agreements to expressly allow “for indemnification for repair, replacement, or maintenance; for operational or structural failure due to a defect in materials or workmanship, normal wear and tear, power surge; or accidental damage from handling of a consumer good or product.”

The bill also defines “vehicle theft protection product” and states that no provision of the insurance title applies to vehicle theft protection product warranties.

Finally, due to South Dakota statutory drafting guidelines, the bill does not contain a list of examples of road hazards or vehicle theft protection products.
