



Title: Utah House Bill 31

Subject: Service Contract Law Amendment

Summary:

Utah House Bill 31 is the Insurance Department's Omnibus bill which makes changes to numerous sections in the insurance code including the Service Contract Law.

Current law requires a service contract and a vehicle protection product warranty to conspicuously state the existence of any deductible amount. This bill adds that any "service fee" must also be conspicuously disclosed.

The term "service fee" is not otherwise used in the bill or service contract statute.

If enacted, this legislation will be effective 60 days following adjournment.
