Subject: Reimbursement Insurance Policies

Summary:

Washington House Bill 1704 is legislation pursued by the SCIC concerning reimbursement insurance policies.

The bill authorizes default reimbursement insurance policies for service contract providers and protection product guarantee providers to demonstrate their financial responsibility.

The bill also authorizes the use of more than one reimbursement insurance policy to back the contracts of service contract providers and protection product guarantee providers.
