



**Title:** Wyoming House Bill 64

**Subject:** Protection Products

**Summary:**

**This bill has been signed by the Governor and will be effective July 1, 2022.**

Wyoming House Bill 64 is legislation pursued by MVPPA to authorize key fob coverage, excess wear and use protection, and windshield replacement as a service contact.

The bill states that theft protection program warranties shall not be considered insurance and authorizes incidental theft protection program payments.

Current law defines service contract to include coverage for tire and wheel, paintless dent repair, and windshield repair.

The bill defines the terms "road hazard," "incidental theft protection payment," "theft protection program," and "theft protection program warranty."
